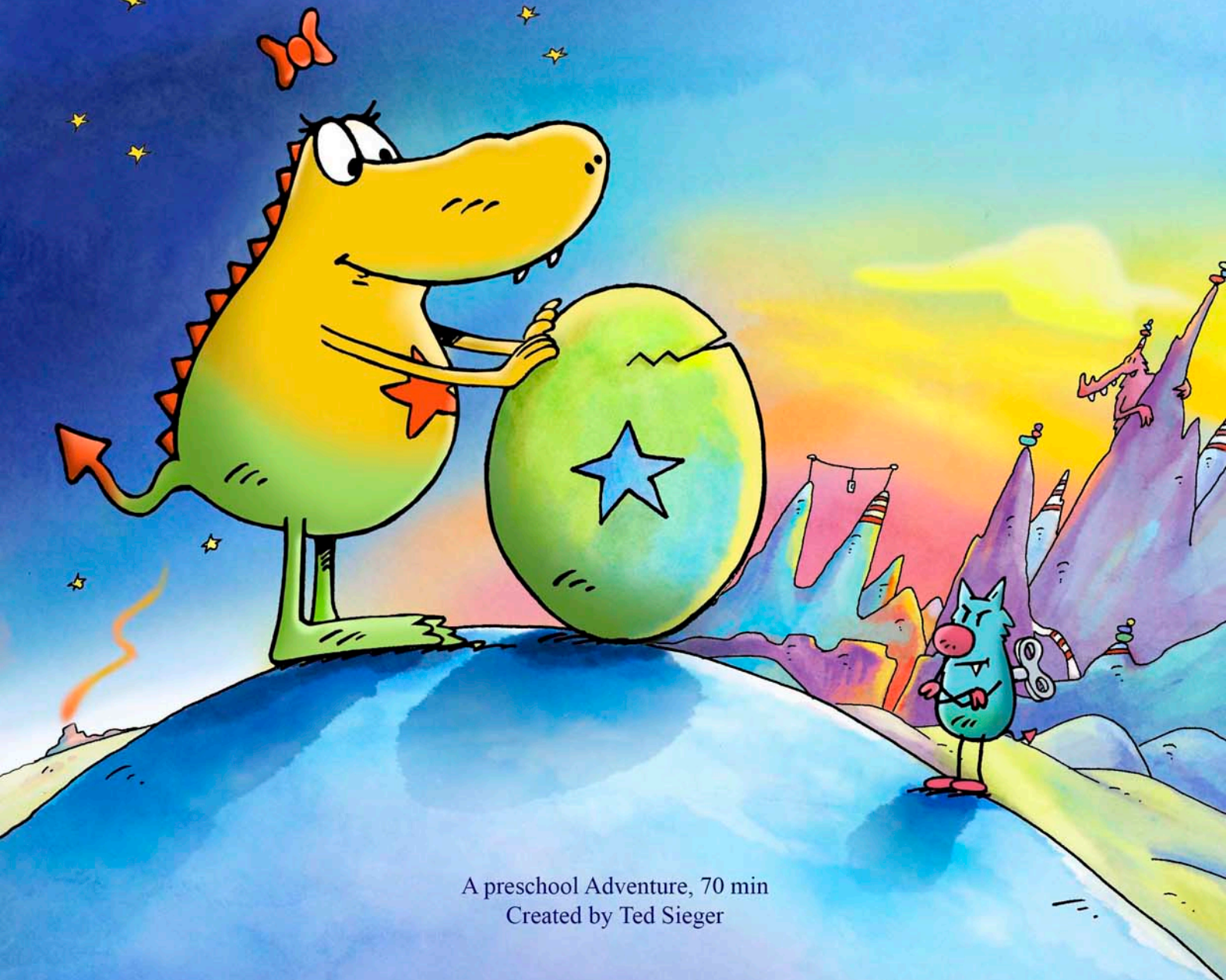

But "Molly Monster - The Movie" is more than that.

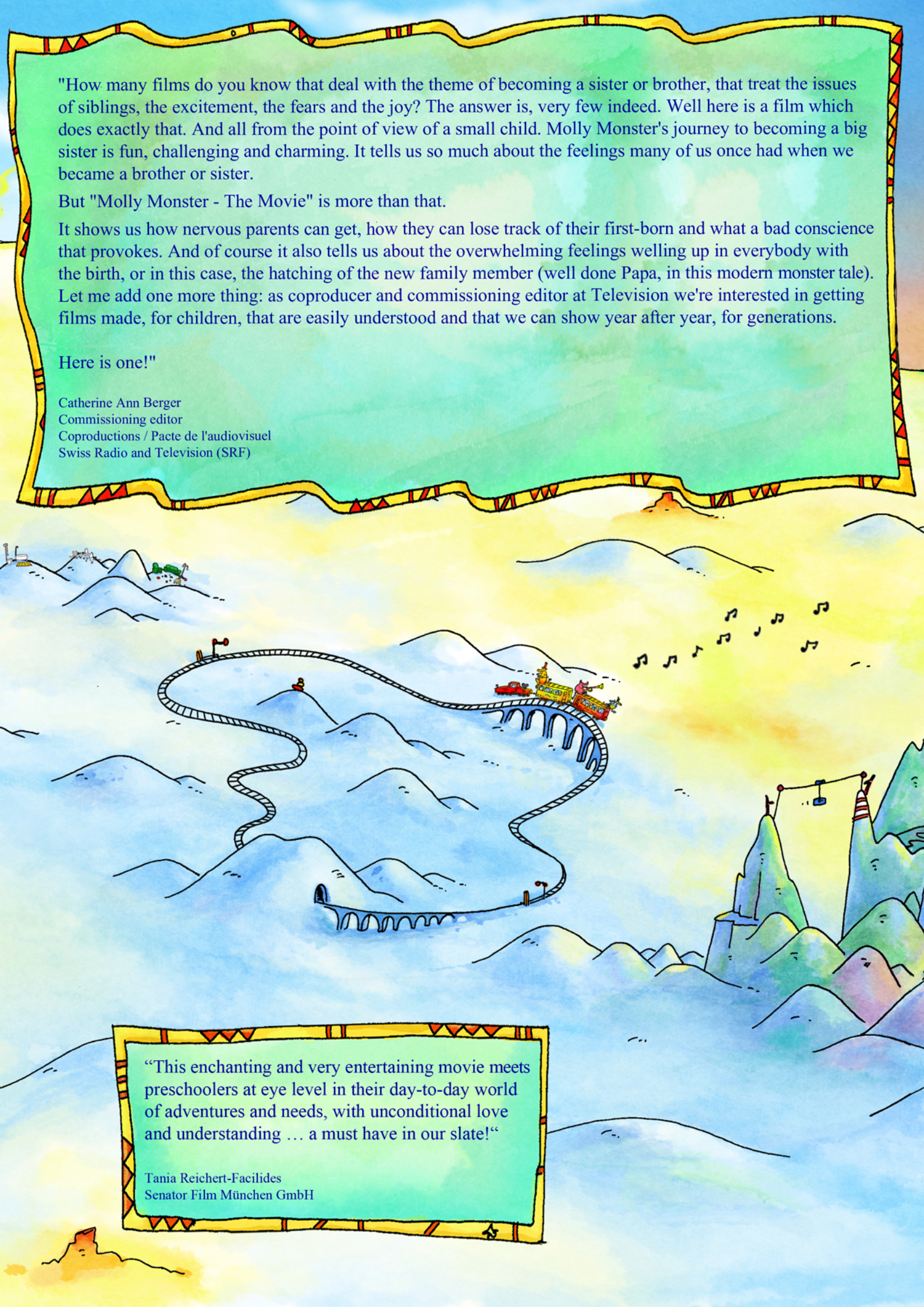
